Please type directly on the application, as it is a fillable document. Your application must be saved on your computer or device and then e-mailed to upcen10@gmail.com.

II. <u>Minimum Eligibility Requirements</u>:

- a. Scholarship applicant <u>must</u> be a senior graduating high school in 2023.
- b. The scholarship applicant must have attended at least 8 UPCEN workshops in the 2022-2023 calendar year.
- c. The scholarship applicant must have a confirmed GPA of a 2.5 (unweighted) or higher at the time of the application deadline.
- d. Scholarship applicant <u>must</u> have taken the ACT or the SAT

III. Minimum Criteria for Selection:

- \Box a. All essays must be at least 1,0000 words.
- b. All essays must be included with the application at the time of submission.
- C. Spelling and grammatical errors, and lack of minimum words required for essays will disqualify the application.
